#### County (CWAA) and Region (WMAS) Membership Affiliations – 2023/24

All Clubs and Direct Members of Archery Great Britain (AGB) are required to be affiliated to both the Regional Society and the County Association in which the club is located or the direct member resides.

This means that all AGB Clubs and Direct members in Warwickshire must pay affiliations to West Midlands Archery Society (WMAS) and to the County of Warwick Archery Association (CWAA).

The CWAA and WMAS fees should be paid as a combined fee to the CWAA Membership Secretary who will then pass on the WMAS portion of the fee to their treasurer, this makes payment of fees a lot easier for both clubs and direct members.

## When to pay WMAS/CWAA affiliations

All Club and Direct AGB Members must pay affiliations at the same time as they become a member of AGB.

Club and Direct members joining part way through the year will pay pro-rata dependent on when they join (see below)

Club members usually pay affiliations together with their AGB and Club fees at annual renewal.

Direct AGB Members will need to contact the CWAA membership secretary direct, by emailing <a href="membership.secretary@cwaa.org.uk">membership.secretary@cwaa.org.uk</a> to say that they have made a payment into the CWAA account. Please use "Surname\_CWAA" as reference, this is so that the fees do not get lost in the system.

When Clubs are making a payment for affiliations the membership secretary will also need to know who the payments refer to. At the start of the new membership year, when current members are renewing, a list of names and membership numbers with fees paid sent by email to CWAA Membership Secretary will be ok. Later in the year, as late members renew or new members join their details can be sent using the **CWAA Affiliations Form**, or just send information in an email if there are only a couple of renewals.

## What to pay

The table below shows the "Combined WMAS/CWAA fees" payable to CWAA for:

- Members returning to the club any time after the start of the current membership year pay the full combined affiliations, unless they have not been a member of AGB for the previous 18 months.
- New member joining pay at the rate of the appropriate quarter they are joining in.

If a member returns to the club any time after the start of the current membership year then they must pay the full combined affiliations, unless they have not been a member of AGB for the previous 18 months.

**Junior Club** (en bloc)\* membership can only be claimed if you have THREE or more juniors in your club when you make your first CWAA/WMAS payment at the start of the membership year.

If you do not have three or more juniors at the start of the year, then <u>all juniors for this year</u> will pay the single member fees.

**Direct members** shall pay the same affiliation fees as club members, including disability, returning and pro-rata rates.
