SUMMER POSTAL LEAGUE 2024 ENTRY FORM (Free Entry)

RULES

Eligibility

The League is open to all County of Warwick affiliated clubs and is free to enter.

All team members must be affiliated to CWAA.

Divisions

There will be 2 made and 1 adjusted score divisions for Seniors, and the same for Juniors, which will be as follows:

- Made Score All Bow Types Team 4 highest scoring archers of which 2 may be a Compound archer (see Compound Score note below.
- Made Score Unsighted Bows 3 highest scoring archers shooting bows that conform to AGB rules for Barebow or Longbow
- Adjusted Score Team 4 archers with the highest handicap adjusted scores shooting any AGB recognised bow type, who all have valid handicaps assessed on the current AGB Handicap Tables

For the purposes of the League, Juniors will be defined as archers U18 i.e., those whose birthday during 2024 will no more than their 17th.

Archers do not need to be nominated, and any eligible club member may be included in the appropriate team.

Archers scores may be used for both one Made Score Team and the Adjusted Score Team, so where a club enters teams in both Made Score leagues those archers shooting Unsighted Bows may not be included in the All-Bow Types Team.

A club may enter separate Junior and Senior teams, but, if so doing, all Juniors within that club must shoot only for the Junior team throughout the competition. Alternatively, where a Club only enters only a Senior Team, Juniors are eligible for that team and may still shoot the round relevant to their Gender and Age Group.

<u>Compound score</u> – for a Compound Archer's score to be included in the Made Score All Bow types team, their actual made score will be adjusted automatically, using the results spreadsheet, by 7 handicap points, as per the following examples:

Example 1 - actual score of 420, which is 1 point above a handicap of 25. Reducing this by 7 handicap points would take the score to 404, which is the score for a handicap rating of 32 (25+7) plus the extra 1 point that the made score was over the 25 handicap, making a revised score of 405 for inclusion in the team.

Example 2 – actual made score 398, which is 2 points above a handicap of 35. Reducing this by 7 handicap points would take the score to 372, which is the score for a handicap rating of 42 (35+7) plus the extra 2 points that the made score was over the 35 handicap, making a revised score of 374 for inclusion in the team.

For the purposes of the adjusted score team, any number of Compound archers can be included, and their actual score is the one to be used before handicap adjustment, rather than the revised score calculated for the made score team.

Rounds

The results for each of the six divisions will be based on the aggregate team scores of three Warwick rounds, which are to be shot on dates and times pre-defined by the individual club, with a maximum of any two being shot within any of the following periods:

April / May

June / July August / September

Note: The above is to assist Clubs with holidays, or in the case of Universities and Schools, term times.

Where a Club enters a Made Score All Bow Types Team and an Unsighted Bow Team, as defined above, then those teams may shoot on different pre-defined dates, as may any Junior and Senior teams.

Juniors may shoot the round appropriate to their age, as defined below, or may shoot a round for an older group:

Warwick Seniors, Men and Women U18 and Men U16

Warwick 50 Women U16 and Men U15 Warwick 40 Women U15 and Men U14

Warwick 30 Women U14 and Men and Women U12

A record of the overall individual best scores will also be kept for each category, and this will be carried forward from round to round. Trophies will be awarded for the winner of each of the three Senior and the three Junior Team competitions only.

Handicaps

Records Officers and Organisers are requested to ensure that all handicaps are assessed and maintained on a regular basis and strictly in accordance with the Archery GB Handicap Tables released January 2023, including any subsequent amendments applicable at the date the results are submitted.

Results

The Results for each round are to be returned to the Organiser, Martyn Ellis (contact details on results form), within 2 weeks of the end of the shooting period within which they were shot. This rule will normally be strictly adhered to, and it would be helpful if Clubs could notify the Organiser where they are unable to submit a score so that the publishing of the results is not delayed.

Ideally results are to be returned by email using the self-calculating spreadsheet, which simply requires all the coloured cells to be completed. Many of these have drop down selection lists to assist completion of the results. The spreadsheet has been modified this year to calculate the adjusted compound scores. If you do not have access to a suitable spreadsheet application, please contact Martyn Ellis who will provide the form in an alternative format.
